

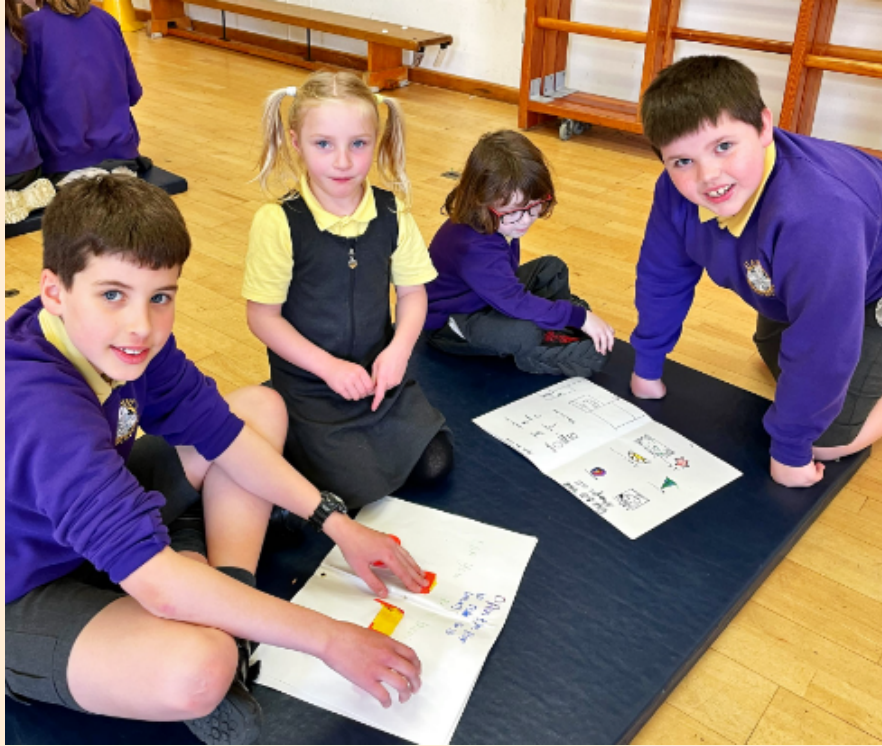

Positive Reinforcement

Positive reinforcement can be used to further encourage a desired behaviour, or change a pre-existing one.

Lots of us use reward charts, this is a form of positive reinforcement.

Use of sentences such as:

“Even though this is challenging, I can tell that you are trying your best”

“I saw how you were helping others. I’m so proud of you”

“You’re really persisting with that, well done”
