<p><b>Emotions</b> – a strong feeling</p> <p><b>Sad</b> - being unhappy.</p> <p><b>Uncomfortable</b> - not feeling comfortable or pleasant.</p> <p><b>Embarrassed</b> - feeling shy about something bad or because you don't want other people to find out about something</p> <p><b>Upset</b> - When someone is unhappy or worried.</p> <p><b>Online</b> controlled by or connected to a computer</p> <p><b>Offline</b> anything not controlled by or connected to a computer.</p> <p><b>Personal Information</b> - information/facts about a person</p> <p><b>Location</b> – a place</p> <p><b>Fact</b> – Something that is true</p> <p><b>Trust</b> – a firm belief in someone or something.</p> <p><b>Trustworthy</b> able to do something that has been asked</p>	<p><b>Self Image</b> online or offline that anyone can say 'no'/'please stop'/'I'll tell'/'I'll ask' to somebody who makes them feel sad, uncomfortable, embarrassed or upset.</p> <p><b>Online Reputation</b> identify ways that they can put information on the internet</p> <p><b>Privacy and security:</b> some simple examples of my personal information (e.g. name, address, birthday, age, location).</p>	<p><b>Self Image</b> They can say 'No' to anyone who makes them feel sad uncomfortable or upset.</p> <p>A Trusted Adult can help them if they feel sad, uncomfortable or upset.</p> <p><b>Privacy and Security</b> Some personal information is only shared with trustworthy people.</p>	<p><b>Privacy and Security</b></p> <p>Describe who a Trusted Adult is.</p> <p>Explain why they can be trusted.</p> <p>Name Trusted Adults in their lives</p> <p>Identify simple examples of personal information.</p>

<p><b>Embarrassed</b> feeling shy about something bad or because you don't want other people to find out about something</p> <p><b>Upset</b> When someone is unhappy or worried.</p> <p><b>Frightened</b> – scary, make you afraid.</p> <p><b>Content</b> – information online</p> <p><b>Devices</b> - a piece of mechanical or electronic equipment.</p> <p><b>Communicating</b> to pass information to others by speaking, writing, moving your body or other signals</p> <p><b>Permission</b> allow someone to do something.</p> <p><b>Password</b> – a secret word on you and trusted adults know to protect information.</p> <p><b>Private information</b> – Details about yourself (age, name, where you live, where you go to school)</p>	<p><b>Self Image</b></p> <p>There are ways in which people communicate with each other both online and offline.</p> <p>there may be people online who could make someone feel sad, embarrassed or upset.</p> <p><b>Online Reputation</b></p> <p>Different information can be shared online in different ways.</p> <p>Some information is personal and should not be shared online.</p> <p><b>Privacy and Security</b></p> <p>That a password helps to protect private information.</p>	<p><b>Self Image</b></p> <p>Not everything online is real or who they say they are.</p> <p>Being friends with someone offline can be different to being friends with them online.</p> <p>Things can happen online that make us feel sad, worried, uncomfortable or frightened.</p> <p><b>Online Reputation</b></p> <p>How some information that we may share online could put us at risk and what those risks are.</p> <p><b>Privacy and Security</b></p> <p>that passwords are used to protect information, accounts and devices.</p>	<p><b>Self Image</b></p> <p>give examples of when and how to speak to an adult they can trust and how they can help.</p> <p>Explain why it is important to have more than one trusted adult to talk to.</p> <p><b>Online Reputation</b></p> <p>Give examples of what we mean by personal information.</p> <p>Explain why you should not share personal information online.</p> <p>explain why it is important to always ask a trusted adult before sharing any personal information online, belonging to myself or others.</p>
