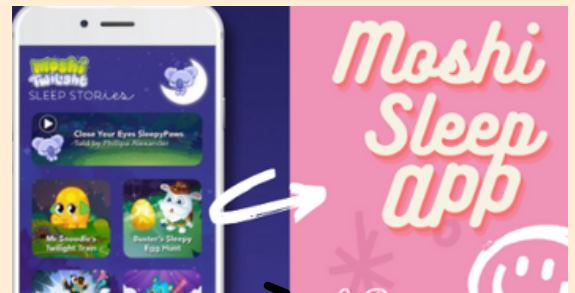
E SAFETY TIPS: AGE LIMITS
