We even took our learning outdoors during Forest School, where we worked together to create a beautiful Solar System display to hang in our classroom ready for September.

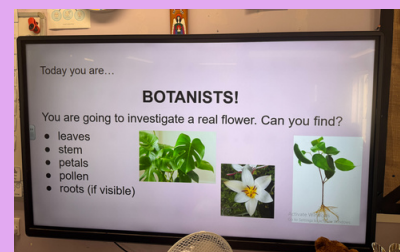

Many children enjoy watching others play games online through platforms like YouTube or Twitch. While this can be entertaining and even educational, it's important to be aware that livestreams often include live chat features and content aimed at older audiences.

Children may be exposed to inappropriate language, adverts, or interactions with strangers.

Encourage children to stick to age-appropriate channels, turn off or avoid live chat where possible, and talk to you about what they are watching.

Watching together occasionally can also help you understand what they enjoy.
